All communications including electronic and non-electronic, are essential for sharing club news and information with the Mindarie Netball Club members. Our communication will be of a professional manner, timely, appropriate and of club related business.

WHAT WE WILL DO

Mindarie Netball Club uses a wide variety of electronic tools to communicate with our members. Listed below is a range of electronic communications we use for club business:

Any Mindarie Netball Club team that wishes to create their own social media page, must have the social media name in their own team name only. No reference to the Mindarie Netball Club is to be put within the social media page name. One committee member must be on all pages, Social media pages may include Instagram, Youtube, Facebook, TikTok etc.

WEBSITE

Our website will include relevant and current information on upcoming events, competitions, policies, rules etc.



We will continuously seek feedback from members and the community to improve the information provided on the Mindarie Netball Club's website.

MOBILE PHONE AND EMAIL

All coaches, team managers, umpires, committee members and other relevant members of the Mindarie Netball Club may use SMS and email as a form of communication. Information regarding competition, training, game day, club events and other club related business may be communicated via these mediums. However, communication involving children under the age of 16, must be

directed through their parent/guardian. The Club will not pass on any phone numbers or email addresses to other members or other third parties without consent.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION

Mindarie Netball Club will respect and maintain the privacy of all members when communicating electronically. All electronic communication, such as Facebook, will be restricted to club matters only and will not bring the club into disrepute. The electronic mediums must not offend, intimidate, humiliate or bully other members of the club and must not be misleading, false or injure the reputation of another person/member/club.

NON-COMPLIANCE

Members may face disciplinary action for the following offences:

- sending inappropriate electronic communication
- posting online content or comments that may relate to any form of harassment, bullying, humiliation etc. of another person/member
- bringing the Mindarie Netball Club to disrepute in any way
